## Dredging resumes in Manatee Pocket

PORT SALERNO — The dredging of the Manatee Pocket in Port Salerno has resumed after a brief pause in January to remove the sediment collected at the dredged material management area on Southeast Federal Highway in Stuart.

It is anticipated that dredging will be temporarily halted one more time to manage the sediment removal prior to the completion of the project by November.

The contractor, Dickerson Florida Inc., will continue dredging in the main channel outside of Chapman Creek. Beginning Feb. 7, Dickerson will begin dredging on a 14-hour schedule, from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m., seven days per week. The slight schedule change was made to maximize the amount of work completed during daylight hours.
